

Development





- Collaboration between the European Pressure Ulcer Advisory Panel (EPUAP), National Pressure Injury Advisory Panel (NPIAP) and the Pan Pacific Pressure Injury Alliance (PPPIA).
- 14 wound organizations from 12 countries joined as Associate Organizations
- Full development team = 181 academic and clinical experts, including the 12-member guideline governance group, a methodologist and 168 working group members.

Development

- Research published up to August 2018 was critically appraised and analysed
- 114 evidence-based recommendations supported by an overview of the underpinning research

WHO IS SCENTR?





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
- Design, perform, analyse and publish high- quality research about efficacy, effectiveness, and efficiency of treatment interventions
